Sandusky County Habitat for Humanity Establishes “Seeds of Shelter Endowment Fund” to Strengthen Long-Term Housing Impact

Fremont- Sandusky County – Sandusky County Habitat for Humanity and the Sandusky County Communities Foundation has announced the creation of the Seeds of Shelter Endowment Fund, a new permanent endowment established to support the long-term sustainability and growth of Sandusky County Habitat for Humanity.

The Seeds of Shelter Endowment Fund has been created to provide a stable, reliable funding source to strengthen the organization’s ability to serve families in need of safe, decent, and affordable housing.

“This endowment represents an investment in the future of housing stability in Sandusky County,” said Pam Kensler Executive Director, Sandusky County Habitat for Humanity. “The Seeds of Shelter Endowment Fund will allow us to plan more strategically, reduce reliance on unpredictable funding sources, and continue expanding our impact in the communities we serve.”

The Fund is designed to support critical areas of Habitat’s work, including:

- Property acquisition to expand housing opportunities
- Multi-home infrastructure to increase building capacity and efficiency
- Operational sustainability to maintain standards and support future growth

“The establishment of this endowment strengthens Habitat’s ability to serve families not just today, but for generations to come,” said Andrea Gibson, former Executive Director of the Sandusky County Communities Foundation. “Permanent funds like the Seeds of Shelter Endowment Fund ensure that charitable resources are preserved and grown to meet future community needs.”
